1	63C		6	35	1261 RPs may have a need to determine how much they can "trust" a given attribute value; for example whether a subscriber's name was validated during the identity proofing process or is self-asserted. Some examples: whether an email address has been verified by the IdP, or whether a name attribute is self-asserted ("Rich Renomeron") or was obtained from an official source such as a PIV card ("Richard Renomeron (Affiliate)") It's helpful to call this out as a potential source for attribute metadata.	Attribute metadata: Additional information about one or more subscriber attributes, such as those described in NIST Internal Report 8112 [NISTIR8112], or an indication of whether the attribute was validated on creation of the subscriber account.
